

The Total War is when a country uses all the resources to protect itself from the external threats and to win the war. During the process, all the civilians are expected to sacrifice their private needs, and commit themselves to the "spirit of National...justice". This principle applies to everyone, regardless of the class, the economic wealth or the occupations. The people equally share the "burden". In addition, all the luxuries and entertainments that hinder the war effort are dismissed, to maximize the country's strength to win the war. However, the government encourages the amusements that support the war spirit, such as cinema and sports. To conclude, the government controls all the aspects of an individual's life during the Total War.

Total War is defined as a war that involved all German individual in the war, to achieve victory for their nation. To achieve success in the war, every individual, from rich to poor and men to women had to contribute. To ensure that everyone was giving full effort in the war, bars and clubs were to be closed, along with luxury stores and spas. In this way, more labor and electricity could be spent on armaments industry. Everything was done for the German victory. Women were also encouraged to work, and "fill the spot left by men" who left for the front. People needed to "operate quickly, not only thoroughly." Total war has become a "matter of the entire German people," and by including everyone in the war, they would be able to "lead to the goal of victory." Not only contributing the war, but sacrificing personal interest was important, and individual Germans had to take national interests over personal interests.

Total war is when there is an enormous danger and all human and material resources available to a nation are directed towards the war effort. None is wasted: all is used "quickly and thoroughly." There is "community thinking," so that everyone makes equal and great sacrifices, obeys the leader unconditionally, and finds "deepest satisfaction in work and battle" instead of in entertainment and revelry, which are contrary to the "community thinking." The goal, victory, is more important than the means to it. Once it has been achieved, the rewards are great.

Every action taken by the German people must be for the support of the war. Luxuries like beauty, vacation, entertainment and gourmet foods must be eliminated. The people must COLLECTIVELY make PERSONAL sacrifices. "One moral law stands above everything for each of us: to do nothing that harms the war effort, and to do everything that brings victory nearer." No one can escape this law – the German people must conform to a communal standard of living that brings all citizens to the same level. "No one resists even the heaviest burdens of war." Germany demands support from the rest of Europe, because "the future of Europe hangs on our success in the East."

Total war is the collective determination and agreement among the majority of a nation's people to protect their own nation from prospective danger. It embraces the ultimate goal of emerging successful and victorious as a nation; to do so, all citizens of a nation are required to make sacrifices in their everyday lives. The government's radical measures drawn limit the new entertainment opportunities available, as well as the food and fashion choices present, as the "choice is to give up what we love, or lose everything". Men's place during total war is on the battlefields or in industries relating to armaments or the support of the nation's emergence as successful, while the women's place is in the home, closely tied to her responsibility to protect her children. A country will make use of its "full resources, as quickly and thoroughly as possible", and will demand all its citizens' contribution "down to her hour", in order to reach the collective determination to win the battle.

Total war is an effort to protect everything by utilizing every possible resource. All classes are affected, and every single individual must volunteer to sacrifice their standard of living, living a Spartan lifestyle for national victory. Everyone, from soldiers to their wives, must create a willing river of volunteers supporting the war effort, closing every industry that is irrelevant to winning the war.

Total War is the determination to use all resources and all labor to support war efforts. Everyone must do his duty, whether by choice or forced. The goal is to free soldiers for the front and to free workers for the armaments industry. The government will set the broad guidelines but it is the job of the working people to do nothing that harms war efforts, and to do everything that supports them. All aspects of life will be focused on war efforts and it is necessary to make any sacrifice, if it leads to victory.

Total war is using "all [their] resources to protect everything [they] will need in the future", and it is important to use them as "quickly and thoroughly as it is organizationally and practically possible. The only thing important in Total War, is the victory and other "unnecessary concern[s] [are] wholly out of place" and it is not important if the methods are "good or bad, but whether they are successful". The entire population of the country must be involved in the war effort during Total War, class standing becomes unimportant, and the rich and poor "share the burdens equally". Since the population as a whole is involved in Total War, "the individual may have to make great sacrifices", however, these sacrifices are "tiny when compared to the sacrifices he would have to make if his refusal brought down on [them] the greatest national disaster". During Total War it is necessary to impose a series of measure that "maintain moral at home and at the front", these measures include the closing of bars and nightclubs, luxury restaurants and luxury stores. These are not necessary during the war, and only "use electricity, heating and human labor that is lacking everywhere else, especially in the armaments industry".

Total War is when a nation is mobilized for war in every aspect; socially, economically, and politically. All activities in the nation are expected to contribute to the war effort and if they do not in any way, are prohibited from taking place. In this way, personal activities and opinions are repressed and the living standard is lowered significantly. However in a total war, citizens are indoctrinated to believe that the war is a matter of their nations survival, and thus readily comply to the sacrifices which they must make. In this way, total war effectively justifies war and any citizen who does not follow the course of the war, does is not a part of the nation.

The nation must use her full resources as quickly, thoroughly and with organization as possible. If the state losses, all will perish; the state and her leadership are determined to undergo the most radical measures to escape this peril. The people are willing to bear any burden, cross any hardship, make any sacrifice as long as it leads to victory, the greatest goal. "The homeland must stay pure and intact in its entirety. Nothing may disturb the picture." During the war, "fight and let fight". War is not a time of amusement, the public must take its satisfaction into work and battle. However cultural and spiritual institutions serving the public will grow to favor the war moral of the working and fighting people. "The government can only set the broad guidelines. To give life to those guidelines is the job of the working people..." The aim is not to structurally reform the economy, but to win the war as quickly as possible. Moral will remain unbroken, unshaken in the changing fortunes of war.

In total war individuals from different social backgrounds, both women and men, unite to achieve national victory through "superhuman sacrifices" such as "shedding...valuable national blood". The nation uses all methods, good or bad, to achieve victory, where the end justifies the means. Food and free time are unaffordable luxuries.

Total war is the action where the nation's people as a whole must sacrifice their "comforts" in order to work together and defeat the war. Things such as clubs, bars, luxury restaurants and stores, beauty salons and other forms of entertainment are to be closed so that people concentrate on the war. Also people are to be used more efficiently, meaning that people who do not fully work in offices are to be "transferred to war production and replace other men for service at the front. Everyone must learn to pay heed to war morale, and pay attention to the just demands of working and fighting people." No class and sex has priority over the other, there is no discrimination between classes, everyone is to work together in order to win the war. However, for the success of total war the government needs people to also "volunteer".

Total War is when the people have no rights to ignore the war and must obey or contribute to their nation in ways such as economically, politically and socially. People are usually expected to toil without luxuries such as night clubs until the war ends. The nation usually indoctrinates their people to believe in their own nation. In this way, people become more diligent and patriotic towards their nation which leads to less people going to amusement parks. Therefore, Total war is a concept that is used by nations who were putted in the desperate position where winning the war is their only means of survival.

TOTAL WAR IS WHERE A COUNTRY WILL GO THROUGH ANY MEANS TO WIN THE WAR AS FAST AND AS THOROUGHLY AS POSSIBLE: "THE PEOPLE ARE WILLING TO BEAR ANY BUDEN, EVEN THE HEAVIEST, TO MAKE ANY SACRIFICE, IF IT LEADS TO THE GREAT GOAL OF VICOTRY." ALL THE PEOPLE MUST WORK TOGETHER TO OBTAIN THE VICTORY, AND NOT ONE PERSON CAN ESCAPE THE WAR AND THE BURDENS, BECAUSE THEY MUST BE SHARED AMONG EVERYONE. THE ENTIRE POPULATION WILL BE FOCUSED ON ONLY ONE THING: THE WAR. THERE WILL BE NO TIME FOR LUXURY (WHICH IS JUST A WASTE OF TIME, ENERGY, AND POTENCIAL ARMY WORKERS), BECAUSE NO ONE SHOULD HAVE THE TIME AND ENERGY IF THEY ARE WORKING TO THEIR FULL POTENCIAL FOR THE WAR-THE MOST IMPORTANT THING. IN TOTAL WAR THE FOCUS IS ON THE CONSEQUENCES, BECAUSE THE ONLY WAY TO OBTAIN THE VICTORY IS THROUGH SACRIFICE IN THE ECONOMY, LIVING CONDITIONS, AND LIFESTYLE, BUT AFTER THEY WIN THE WAR THROUGH THIS SACRIFICE, THEY WILL GET THEIR COMFORTS BACK AGAIN. "WE WILL BUILD UP THAT WHICH WE ARE NOW ELIMINATING, MORE GENEROUSLY AND MORE BEAUTIFULLY, AND THE STATE WILL LEND ITS HAND." THEY BELIEVE THAT THEY WILL DO NOTHING TO HARM THE WAR EFFORT, AND DO EVERYTHING THAT BRINGS THE VICTORY NEARER.

Total War is the when the people of the nation, of all classes, both men and women, come together to fight in the war. The sacrifices will be made, but the outcome will be even greater. "Those who do not understand that by themselves must be taught to understand". The entertainment will be decreased till Germany has reached victory. Government will help on the sideline, but it is the duty of the people to "volunteer". Total war is the just the necessities, done quickly and thoroughly for Germany to receive victory.
